SEAWEED MINERALS

Seaweed minerals are obtained from Rhodophyta seaweeds.

It is surprisingly contained about 50% potassium and only 1% of Sodium.

Seaweed minerals are extracted by fresh water then powdered by spray drier. White powder, solution is transparent.

Main ingredient is Potassium (about 50%)
